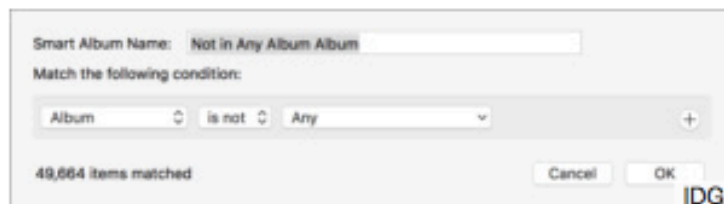


Diana writes in asking:

How can I easily tell which photos are “loose”—not in any album? I’d like to see these “loose” photos, so I can file them.

Fortunately, you can create a smart album to handle this:



A smart album can reveal which photos and videos appear in no albums.

1. Choose *File > New Smart Album*.
2. Select from criteria *Album, Is Not, Any*.
3. Name and click *OK*.

Now you have an album that will only show what you want. As you add media to albums, the smart album updates results.
